T_{wo}EA-M - Enhancing Attractiveness of Environmental Assessment and Management Higher Education

Duration: 24 months

Project description:

The principal objective of the proposed T_{wo}EA-M project is to identify ways on how to enhance international attractiveness of post-graduate European environmental assessment and management (EAM) education, based on the development of a better understanding of European practice and East Asian post-graduate EAM interests and requirements. Furthermore, co-operation opportunities between European and East Asian higher education institutions are sought. The project follows on from an earlier Erasmus Mundus Action 4 project, PENTA (Promotion of European Education on Environmental Assessment for Third Country Audience). In order to achieve this, the following activities/outputs are aimed for:

1. to establish a European and East Asian EAM T_{wo}EA-M project network;
2. to produce a handbook of major types of current EAM programmes and their specialisms in EU member states;
3. to test the usefulness of the educational materials produced during the earlier Erasmus Mundus Action 4 PENTA project for East Asian higher education;
4. to organise three T_{wo}EA-M network EAM conferences with both, European and East Asian speakers in China, South Korea and Thailand; to produce a report on specific East Asian EAM interests and education requirements;
5. to organise a European conference on enhancing international attractiveness of EAM higher education.
